#### Rhubarb Gooey Butter Cake Bars (Betty Crocker)

Prep Time: 15 MIN Total: 3 HRS Servings: 24

#### **Cake Base**

1box Betty Crocker™ Super Moist™ Yellow Cake Mix 1/2cup butter, melted

1egg Filling

1 package (8 oz) cream cheese, softened

3 1/2 cups powdered sugar

1/2 cup butter, melted

**3**eggs

2cups frozen cut rhubarb, thawed, drained or chopped fresh rhubarb



**Topping 1** tablespoon powdered sugar
Serve with sweetened whipped cream

Preheat oven to 350° & spray bottom only of 13x9 pan with cooking spray. In large bowl, stir Cake Base ingredients until well blended. Spread in pan. In another large bowl, beat cream cheese and 3 1/2 cups powdered sugar with electric mixer on medium speed until blended. Beat in 1/2 cup melted butter. Add eggs, one at a time, scraping bowl occasionally. Stir in rhubarb. Pour batter evenly into pan over cake base. Bake 38-43 minutes or til golden brown on edges and center is set. Cool completely, about 2 hours. When ready to serve, sprinkle 1 tablespoon powdered sugar over top. Using sharp knife, cut into 6 rows by 4 rows, cleaning knife blade after each cut. Serve with whipped cream. Store loosely covered in refrigerator.


